WHAT IS THE FRONTLINE DIGNITY HOTLINE?

The Frontline Dignity Rapid Response Hotline exists to support our community when ICE activity is reported.

WHEN YOU CALL, TRAINED VOLUNTEERS MAY BE ABLE TO:

- Document what is happening
 - Support impacted neighbors
 - Help ensure people are not left alone in moments of fear
- Support is offered with care, dignity, and confidentiality.

WHEN SHOULD YOU CALL THE HOTLINE?

- See ICE activity in your neighborhood
- Witness detentions or enforcement actions
- Observe unmarked vehicles or agents questioning people
- Are unsure what you are seeing and want to report safely

HOW TO REPORT

ICE ACTIVITY



SIZE

WHAT TO INCLUDE WHEN REPORTING:

How many agents or vehicles are present?



ACTIVITY

What are they doing? (e.g. stopped someone, at a home, standing in a parking lot)



LOCATION

Be specific, but protect privacy. Do not publicly share home addresses online.



UNIFORM

Plain clothes or uniforms? Visible patches, masks, or tactical gear?



TIME

When did you observe this? Is the situation still active?



EQUIPMENT & VEHICLE

Vehicle descriptions, markings, or plate numbers (if visible).

ICE Hotline: 412-53-NO-ICE

When reporting ICE activity, share only what you directly observe. Do not speculate.
