Trained nearly 3,000 people.



Built a network of more than 1,100 vetted volunteers.



Documented hundreds of incidents across Southwestern Pennsylvania.



Responded to approximately 70 incidents each month.



Connected families affected by detention to legal support, mutual aid, and essential resources.



Developed Frontline PRESENCE, a volunteer-built technology platform strengthening rapid response efforts.



Began sharing our model with communities across the country.



Officially brought on our first full-time staff team this spring.
